

It is, however, also a compound of more than two hundred individual artworks. Their range of reference is wide. Gardening, landscape painting, pastoral poetry, philosophy, history and much else are invoked in the artist's unique, lapidary style of poetry deployed in the landscape; where less is always more and where wit enlivens and illuminates the fundamental seriousness of his work.
